Later, new working groups will convene to develop a shortlist of possible projects and identify:

- What are the key technical deliverables?
- What are the key methodologies?
- Who are the leaders and key partners?
- What is the best source of funding?
- What is the timetable for assembling the proposal and launching?
- What is the potential market value?

The workshop should be of interest to anyone from the industrial or academic sectors with an interest in driving forward the technology in lightweight composites.
